## Floss list for crosses

To calculate the size of a cross stitch design for a pattern that is 145 x 200 stitches, assuming you are using 14-count fabric, here's the process:

Identify the Fabric Count: We'll use 14-count fabric, which means there are 14 stitches per inch.

Calculate the Size in Inches:

For the width: Divide the number of stitches (145) by the fabric count (14). So, 145 stitches / 14 stitches per inch = approximately 10.36 inches.

For the height: Divide 200 stitches by 14 stitches per inch. So, 200 stitches / 14 stitches per inch = approximately 14.29 inches.

Calculate the Size in Centimeters:

Convert inches to centimeters (1 inch = 2.54 cm).

For the width: 10.36 inches \* 2.54 cm/inch = approximately 26.31 centimeters.





























For the height: 14.29 inches \* 2.54 cm/inch = approximately 36.27 centimeters.

Therefore, for a 145 x 200 stitch pattern on 14-count fabric, the design will approximately measure 10.36 inches (26.31 cm) in width and 14.29 inches (36.27 cm) in height.

Remember to include extra fabric around the edges for framing or finishing your cross stitch project.
