How to Convert Cross Stitch Pattern Sizes: A Step-by-Step Guide

When you download a cross stitch pattern, you'll often find the design size expressed in stitches, such as "Design size: 200 x 200 stitches." To determine the physical dimensions of your design, you need to know the fabric's thread count, typically referred to as the "count." In this guide, we'll walk you through converting stitch count to inches and centimeters for a 14-count Aida fabric.

Understanding Fabric Count

The fabric count indicates how many threads (or squares) there are per inch. For example, a 14-count Aida fabric has 14 stitches per inch. This information is crucial for calculating the physical size of your cross stitch design.

Example Calculation for 200 x 200 Stitches on 14-Count Aida

Given:

Design size: 200 x 200 stitches

Fabric count: 14-count Aida

Steps to Calculate:

Calculate the size in inches:

Width: 200 stitches ÷ 14 stitches per inch = 14.29 inches

Height: 200 stitches ÷ 14 stitches per inch = 14.29 inches

Convert inches to centimeters (1 inch = 2.54 cm):

Width: 14.29 inches × 2.54 cm/inch = 36.30 cm

Height: 14.29 inches × 2.54 cm/inch = 36.30 cm

Summary of Dimensions for 14-Count Aida

Width: 14.29 inches (36.30 cm)

Height: 14.29 inches (36.30 cm)
