How to Convert Cross Stitch Pattern Sizes: A Step-by-Step Guide (250 x 300 Stitches)

When your pattern reads "250 x 300 stitches," you'll want to know the real-world dimensions. To calculate this, you need the fabric count, which tells you how many stitches fit into one inch. This example uses 14-count Aida.

Understanding Fabric Count

Fabric count = stitches per inch.

14-count Aida = 14 stitches per inch.

Example Calculation for 250 x 300 Stitches on 14-Count Aida

Given:

Design size: 250 x 300 stitches

Fabric count: 14-count Aida

Steps:

Convert stitches to inches:

Width: $250 \div 14 = 17.86$ inches

Height: $300 \div 14 = 21.43$ inches

Convert inches to centimeters (1 inch = 2.54 cm):

Width: $17.86 \times 2.54 = 45.37$ cm

Height: $21.43 \times 2.54 = 54.43$ cm

Summary of Dimensions for 14-Count Aida

Width: 17.86 inches (45.37 cm)

Height: 21.43 inches (54.43 cm)

Conclusion

This conversion helps you confidently cut your fabric and prepare for framing. Always add extra margins for finishing—typically 2–3 inches on each side.
