How to Convert Cross Stitch Pattern Sizes: A Step-by-Step Guide (300 x 300 Stitches)

When your pattern reads "300 x 300 stitches," you'll need to translate that into actual fabric dimensions. This depends on the fabric count—how many stitches fit into one inch.

We'll use 14-count Aida fabric for this example, a common choice for cross stitchers.

Understanding Fabric Count

Fabric count = stitches per inch.

14-count Aida means 14 stitches fit into one inch of fabric.

Example Calculation for 300 x 300 Stitches on 14-Count Aida

Given:

Design size: 300 x 300 stitches

Fabric count: 14-count Aida

Steps:

Convert stitches to inches:

Width: $300 \div 14 = 21.43$ inches

Height: $300 \div 14 = 21.43$ inches

Convert inches to centimeters (1 inch = 2.54 cm):

Width: $21.43 \times 2.54 = 54.43$ cm

Height: $21.43 \times 2.54 = 54.43$ cm

Summary of Dimensions for 14-Count Aida

Width: 21.43 inches (54.43 cm)

Height: 21.43 inches (54.43 cm)

Conclusion

This quick calculation gives you the exact size of your finished design on 14-count fabric. Always add extra inches on each side for framing or hooping.
