How to Convert Cross Stitch Pattern Sizes: A Step-by-Step Guide (190 x 200 Stitches)

Cross stitch patterns often list the size in stitches—like "190 x 200 stitches." To know how large the finished piece will be, you need the fabric count, which tells you how many stitches fit in one inch.

This example uses 14-count Aida fabric, which is common for cross stitch projects.

Understanding Fabric Count

Fabric count = number of stitches per inch.

On 14-count Aida, you'll get 14 stitches in each inch.

Example Calculation for 190 x 200 Stitches on 14-Count Aida
Given:

Design size: 190 x 200 stitches

Fabric count: 14-count Aida

Steps:

Convert stitches to inches:

Width: $190 \div 14 = 13.57$ inches

Height: $200 \div 14 = 14.29$ inches

Convert inches to centimeters (1 inch = 2.54 cm):

Width: $13.57 \times 2.54 = 34.47$ cm

Height: $14.29 \times 2.54 = 36.30$ cm

Summary of Dimensions for 14-Count Aida

Width: 13.57 inches (34.47 cm)

Height: 14.29 inches (36.30 cm)

Conclusion

This simple conversion helps you plan your fabric cut and framing. Be sure to add extra margins for ease in finishing your cross stitch piece.
